SUMMER STUDENT INTERN PROGRAM

To be considered for our student intern program, you must be a U.S. citizen, have completed your freshman year in college, and be enrolled for the fall semester. The salaries for these positions range from \$2000 to \$3000 per month depending on the student's discipline and class status.

CO-OP PROGRAM

The co-op program is a structured program that combines classroom instruction with work experience in the student's area of study. To qualify for this program, students must:

- be enrolled in an engineering or scientific discipline,
- meet the requirements of their institution's co-op program, and
- be a U.S. citizen.

The salaries for co-op students range from \$2000 to \$3000 per month depending on the student's discipline and class status. Co-op students are also eligible for certain company benefits.
