

**Expression of Interest
Liquid Waste Management Services
B & W Y-12, Oak Ridge Tennessee**

March 28, 2013

PURPOSE

Babcock & Wilcox Technical Services Y-12, L.L.C. (B&W), acting under its Prime Contract No. DE-AC05-00OR22800 with the United States Department of Energy (DOE), is posting this Expression of Interest (EOI) to identify firms capable of, and interested in performing Liquid Waste Management Services at the Y-12 National Security Complex located in Oak Ridge, Tennessee. Responses received will be used for planning purposes for subsequent procurement actions, if any.

The work scope includes, but is not limited to, mobilization, permitting, wastewater receipt and acceptance, wastewater management and treatment operations, treatment system, facility, grounds, and equipment surveillance and maintenance, characterization and transportation of wastewaters and secondary wastes, reporting, and demobilization.

The Seller will perform all necessary functions to manage, treat, and disposition the existing inventory of wastewater and sludge within the first 2 years of the subcontract as well as all wastewater received and all sludge generated. The Seller will ensure that all waste meets facility and system acceptance criteria for the Company at Y-12 in a manner that ensures protection of the workforce, the public, and the environment. The Seller shall furnish all labor, equipment, materials, supplies, and transportation as needed to perform all liquid waste management operations and maintenance activities. The Seller is expected to promote waste minimization, pollution prevention, and recycling at Y-12 and shall implement these practices in accordance with the Seller's plans and this agreement.

This EOI is simply a means to identify potentially qualified and interested bidders.

PROCUREMENT PROCESS

The Company is looking for qualified business of all sizes capable of being determined to be technically and commercially qualified and capable of performing this work.

This is not a small business set-aside. If it is determined by B&W Y-12 that there is a sufficient number of small business capable of winning this work, the RFP will revert to a small business set-aside. Should there be an insufficient number of qualified small businesses expressing interest; the acquisition strategy will remain "full and open".

This is not two part procurement in that this EOI is not a prequalification exercise.

This EOI request is not an invitation for sealed bids (IFB), or a request for proposal (RFP) and B&W makes no representation that a procurement will result from this EOI. Responding to this EOI does not guarantee that respondent will be invited to participate in the solicitation phase of this work. The tentative schedule for issuing an RFP for the Liquid Waste Management Services is August – September 2013.

This document has been reviewed by a Y-12 DOE UCNI-RO and has been determined to be UNCLASSIFIED and contains no UCNI. This review does not constitute clearance for Public Release.

EOI SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

The answer to the following questions must be "YES". Respondents must include evidence with their reply that supports the affirmative answer.

1. Does Respondent have, or is the Respondent able to obtain, a favorable Foreign Ownership, Control and Influence (FOCI) Determination (i.e., no foreign ownership)? If the Respondent has been rendered a favorable FOCI, provide the DOE Facility Clearance Code or the DOD Cage Code.
2. Does the Respondent, teaming partner(s) and subcontractor(s) each have an EMR rating less than or equal to 1.0 for the past three (3) calendar years? Provide letter from worker's compensation insurance carrier with EMR rating for the past three (3) years.
3. Do the Respondent, teaming partner(s) and subcontractor(s)' Total Recordable Injury /Illness Rate and Average Lost Work Day Rate fall within the applicable statistical standards for your business category?
4. Do the Respondent, teaming partner(s) and subcontractor(s) have experience in integration of environment, safety, and health into work planning and execution [i.e., Integrated Safety Management (ISM)], Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) compliance to support management and operations of facilities that process potentially hazardous liquid waste?
5. Does the Respondent have aggregate bonding (payment & performance bonds) capacity for \$5 million? Provide evidence from an approved surety as listed on the U.S. Treasury Circular 570.
6. Does the Respondent have a Quality Assurance Program that is based on the national standard of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Nuclear Quality Assurance (NQA)-1, *Quality Assurance Requirements for Nuclear Facility Applications*, 2008 (2009 Addendum)?

ADDITIONAL REQUESTED INFORMATION

1. Submit evidence that the Respondent has past and present experience performing Liquid Waste Management Services. Provide a list of relevant projects for the last five (5) years which includes a brief description of the work, total cost of the project, total cost of your portion of the project, verifiable references including company name, telephone numbers, contact names and email addresses.
2. Is the Respondent or teaming partner(s) and/or subcontractor(s) listed on the U.S. Government's "List of Parties Excluded from Federal procurement and Non-Procurement Programs Lists"? Are parties aware of any current action by the Government that would preclude the firm from participating?
3. Respondent shall provide its Dunn and Bradstreet (DUNS Number) and overall financial rating.
4. Provide evidence that professional liability (E&O) insurance is carried by the Offeror with a minimum limit of \$1M dollars.

CLOSING DATE FOR SUBMISSIONS

Your written responses are required no later than 12:00 PM, Eastern Time on April 16, 2013. Please limit your response to ten (10) pages or less. Include in your response, the name, title, address, telephone number, facsimile number, and e-mail address of the responsible person to whom future communications regarding a possible RFP should be addressed. Provide a written statement signed by an authorized company official that the information is current, accurate, and complete to the best of the individual's knowledge.
