## **Proposed Action Description:**

The Y-12 National Security Complex's (Y-12) provides critical and specialized enriched uranium (EU) processing, manufacturing, and storage capa bilities. In 2013, Y-12 proposed to establish an electrochemical means for converting impure uranium oxide to purified uranium metal using an Electrorefining (ER) process. Such a metal to metal purification process would (1) eliminate many of the process steps in the current production process, (2) improve safety through the elimination of many wet chemistry systems and associated hazards and (3) significantly reduce high-equity EU solution handling. Y-12 would design, procure, install, test, and operate an ER process to replace the current metal purification operations. The NEPA 4624, rev 1, categorical exclusion determination was originally issued in 2015 and NEPA 4624, rev 2 was re-issued in 2019 (not publicly available) on a revised US DOE Categorical Exclusion Determination form (changed as a result of US District Court ruling). The purpose of this addendum to NEPA 4624, rev 2 is to make publicly available a version of the 2019 issued CX.
