The Veterans to Engineers (VTE) program, sponsored by Consolidated Nuclear Security, is a development program for military veterans pursuing an engineering degree from an Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET)—accredited college or university. VTE program participants gain on-the-job engineering experience in a paid, part-time internship role while pursuing their degree, with the opportunity for future full-time employment.
